

The Tsao Foundation strives to help older persons realise opportunities in longevity by being a catalyst for constructive systemic and mindset change. This mission is undertaken through four synergistic core initiatives:

- **Community for Successful Ageing (ComSA)** takes a community-wide approach to forge an integrated system of comprehensive programmes and services with the aim to promote health and wellbeing over the life course, and to enable ageing in place.
- **Hua Mei Centre for Successful Ageing** which enables ageing-in-place by pioneering replicable, community-based, integrated health and psychosocial age care service models grounded in person-centred principles

Care Manager-Social Work (2-year Contract)

The Care Manager (Social Work) is to provide psycho-social assessment, coordination and intervention to support and enable the older person to live at home in optimal health.

Main Responsibilities

- Administer Psycho-social assessment for existing clients;
- Develop Psycho-social Care Plan, initiate inter-disciplinary team discussion and facilitate its implementation, including regular reviews;
- Link, mobilize and act as broker (mediating, facilitating, negotiating and coordinating) for appropriate services for clients and family in order to establish a viable support network;
- Liaise and network with relevant social and community service agencies to establish or enhance the clients' social support system;
- Conduct family conferences when the need arises;

Requirements:

This is a 2-year contract position, subject to renewal.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and Psychology Discipline in a recognized University;

Experience

- At least 3 years' working experience in social service agencies, preferably with older persons;
- Knowledge of Psycho-social assessment and Care Plans formulation is essential;
- Training/ Experience in gerontology will be an advantage;
- A strong team player, able to work independently and as part of a multidisciplinary team;

Other Skills

- Excellent interpersonal and effective networking skills
- Strong commitment and passion in working with older persons
- Good communication and writing skills
- Ability to communicate in English, Mandarin and understand simple dialects with Chinese/ dialect speaking clients
- Has a penchant for home visits
- Enjoy the challenges of community interventions
