Additional options to supplement care for your senior at home Click each box to find out more.

Home Medical

- For frail and homebound seniors who require doctor's consultation at home
- E.g. Examinations, reviews, medication prescription

Home Nursing

- For frail and homebound seniors who require nursing care at home.
- E.g. injections, wound dressing, and tube changes

Home Therapy

- home-based rehabilitation services such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy.
- Senior must have difficulty attending centre-based therapy to be eligible



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Home Personal Care

 For homebound seniors who require assistance with personal services to continue living well at home e.g. personal hygiene, house keeping and other activities of daily living.

Medical Transport & Escort

 Transport and escort personnel to accompany seniors to and from medical appointments



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Hospice Home Care

 Care at home for seniors with lifelimiting illnesses.

Meals-on-Wheels

Meal delivery to frail and homebound seniors

Day Care Centre

- Full-day programme in centre-based care setting
- Therapy-focused; maintaining and/or improving the general, physical and social well-being of seniors
- Socialisation and recreational activities.
- Specialised day care centres cater to specific needs: Dementia Day care, Day Hospice Care, Day Respite Care. Click to find out more



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Community Rehab Centre

 Provide therapy for seniors who need help to regain ability to perform their activities of daily living.

Centre-based Nursing

Provides basic nursing care for seniors

Senior Activity Centre

- Encourages active aging
- Functions as a communal spaces for seniors to engage socially
- Located at void decks of HDB rental flats




Integrated Home and Day Care (IHDC)

- Seamless and holistic care for frail seniors who are otherwise eligible for nursing home placement.
- Comprehensive and personalised package of home and centre-based care services, depending on needs, with the aim of maintaining independence and active ageing in the community for as long as possible.
- Also includes caregiver support, and allows frail seniors to continue staying at home with their loved ones.
