

## **Position: Physical/ Occupational Therapist**

### **Clinical Affairs**

#### **Responsibilities**

##### *Assessment, Planning and Evaluation*

- Assess and identify the individual need of clients with respect to various occupational performance issues at the centre and/or at home
- Work with other disciplines (Medical, Nursing and Social Work) to ensure team understanding of client occupational performance strengths and needs
- Develop occupationally based intervention plans based on clients' needs and assessment
- Participate in Interdisciplinary meetings to review and evaluate results, integrate findings with other disciplines, offer recommendations, and develop individual /group intervention plans to achieve care plan goals.

##### *Service Delivery*

- Implement targeted, evidence-based individual and group therapeutic intervention to facilitate client participation and occupational performance at the centre/ or at home
- Work with Programme Assistants on intervention implementation
- Adapt and/or modify the environment including assistive technology and training staff to meet individual needs and to help clients function as independently as possible
- Educate client, centre staff and family members to facilitate skills in assisting the areas of occupation, health maintenance and safety
- Review the effects of occupational therapy intervention and the need to continue, modify, or discontinue intervention
- Document occupational therapy services to ensure accountability of service provision

##### *Program Administration and Management*

Work in conjunction with the head of programmes to:-

- Prioritize and schedule work tasks
- Maintain clinical and administrative records in accordance with organisational structure
- Guide Programme Assistant to perform occupational therapy with patients
- Review occupational therapy services for quality improvement and makes changes as needed to ensure quality of services
- Provide support for the implementation of the functional practice roll out across the various services

#### **Requirements**

- Degree or Diploma in Occupational/ Physiotherapy
- Full registration with Allied Health Professional Council
- Must have interest to work with the elderly in the social service sector
